# **Duct Strap Installation**

# Tools & Materials Needed:

- Dundee Manufacturing Duct Strap
- Screws, nails, or fasteners (appropriate for mounting surface)
- Drill or hammer
- Measuring tape
- Scissors or tin snips
- Pencil or marker



# Step-by-Step Installation:

#### 1. Measure and Cut

- Determine the required length of the duct strap for securing the duct.
- Use scissors or tin snips to cut the strap to the correct size.

#### 2. Mark Attachment Points

- Measure and mark the locations on the ceiling, wall, or support structure where the strap will be secured.
- Ensure even spacing to properly support the duct.

## 3. Secure One End of the Strap

- o Position the strap's end at the marked point.
- Use screws, nails, or other fasteners to attach it securely to the surface.



## 4. Loop Around the Duct

 Wrap the duct strap around the duct, ensuring it fits snugly but does not compress or damage the duct.

### 5. Secure the Other End

- Pull the strap tight to provide proper support.
- Attach the second end to the ceiling, wall, or other structural support using the appropriate fastener.

## 6. Final Inspection

- Ensure the duct is evenly supported and that the strap is securely fastened.
- Check that the duct has some flexibility but does not sag excessively.

# Safety Tips:

- Always wear protective eyewear when installing.
- Do not overtighten the strap, as this may damage flexible ducts.
- Use appropriate fasteners for your mounting surface to ensure a secure hold.
